



Volunteer Policy

For WFSC to succeed in achieving its vision and objectives it relies greatly on the skills, knowledge and commitment of its volunteer workforce.

Volunteers are vital in supporting participants, club members and coaches. Without such a dedicated body of enthusiastic people development and progression is not possible.

All volunteers must become members of the Club and ASA and will be subject to a satisfactory CRB check.

All volunteers working with the Club will be expected to attend all relevant training courses to their role and will be given a named contact person to support him or her throughout their volunteering role.

The Board of Trustees or another appropriate person is available to discuss with prospective volunteers how their skills and knowledge would be best placed within the Club structure.

Volunteers must respect the principles of confidentiality. The only exception to breaking this confidentiality is to report concerns relating to child protection issues.

All volunteers must comply with the Club Volunteer Code of Practice, Club Policies and fulfil the agreed Role Description where appropriate.
